In its initial years, MSKS dedicated its efforts to increasing the capacities and expertise of the Charitable health care service providers who are working in remote areas. Also, MSKS played an important role in providing support during natural calamities-

As time unfolded, MSKS expanded its scope by initiating various interventions to address the community health issues of marginalized individuals within society.

At present MSKS is implementing various health, nutrition, skill training, HIV/AIDS, Ambulance services, prevention of child marriage, and livelihood related projects and programs in Gopalganj, Bihar.

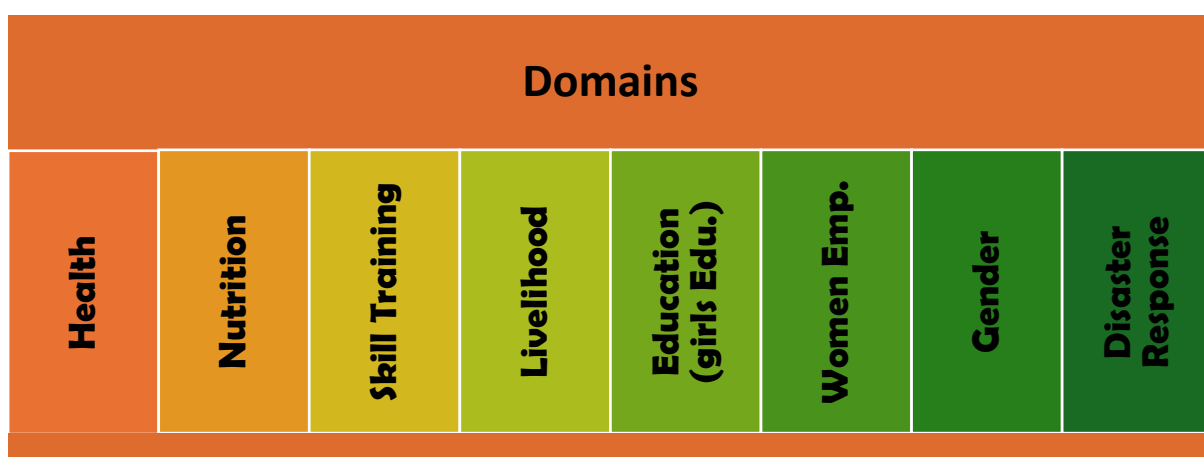

As Mahila Shishu Kalyan Sansthan Evam Hast Shilp Kala Prashiksan Kendra completed five-decade, organization focuses with this strategic plan to step forward the next level of its excellence. The plan honors our founding commitment to serve the poor and marginalized communities of Bihar. The strategic plan provide direction, providing a focus and helps the organization to decide priorities for next 5 years i.e. 2023-28.

Program Priorities:

1. **Sexual and Reproductive Health:** Focus on maternal health, family planning, and adolescent health, targeting women aged 15-35 and adolescents aged 10-19.
2. **Malnutrition & Anaemia:** Address malnutrition and anaemia among pregnant women, adolescents, and young children.
3. **Communicable, Non-Communicable, and Vector-Borne Diseases:** Raise awareness and improve healthcare for diseases like TB, HIV/AIDS, and hypertension.
4. **Child Marriage:** Delay child marriage by working with children and youth aged 10-18 years, promoting education and sexual and reproductive health.

5. **Health Care Access:** Improve healthcare services in the hard to reach areas, for homeless and slum dwellers, promoting AYUSH.
6. **Mental Health:** Pilot programs on mental health, providing psychosocial care to youth, married couples, and the homeless.
7. **Safe Drinking Water and Sanitation:** Promote access to safe drinking water and improved sanitation.
8. **Climate-Resilient Livelihoods:** Promote sustainable livelihoods like goat farming, organic farming, back yard poultry, reducing climate vulnerability.

MSKS's programs will cover Gopalganj District, Bihar expanding based on need and focusing on creating models for replication, collaboration, and government engagement.

Organizational Structure and Decision Making

General Body: MSKS's decision-making authority resides in its General Body. General Body meetings are held annually and can be convened more frequently if necessary. This body plays a vital role in approving the Annual Activity Report, Audit Report, the selection of MSKS's auditor, and shaping policy decisions to enhance MSKS's programs and operations.

Governing Board: From the General Body, 9 members are elected as Governing Board Members. The Governing Board meets at least quarterly to review MSKS's activities and make policy decisions. This board provides guidance and oversight for MSKS's programs and operations.

2. **Transforming Nutritional Health:** Through targeted interventions, MSKS has improved the nutritional health of 500 children, women, and adolescents by promoting growth monitoring, nutritious local foods, and kitchen gardening, effectively addressing malnutrition in marginalized communities.
3. **Mobilizing 2000 Children for MR Vaccination:** MSKS's outstanding effort in mobilizing nearly 2,000 children for Measles-Rubella vaccinations Gopalganj districts of Bihar highlights its dedication to safeguarding children's health and supporting national immunization efforts.
4. **Supporting People with Disabilities:** MSKS provided critical support to 200 people with disabilities, including vaccinating 300 individuals against COVID-19, demonstrating a commitment to inclusivity and health equity for vulnerable populations.

8. **Vocational Skills for Youth:** MSKS has trained 2,500 youth in vocational skills, enhancing their employability and enabling them to contribute to their families and communities' economic growth.
9. **Empowering Women in Agriculture & Livestock:** By supporting 100 women in goat farming, back yard poultry and agricultural activities, MSKS is promoting economic independence and empowering women to lead sustainable livelihoods.
10. **Domestic Violence Awareness:** MSKS has sensitized 500 women and girls about domestic and gender-based violence, offering counseling and legal support to survivors, ensuring their safety and dignity.
